HUGE CONGRATULATIONS TO NOREEN

We are delighted to congratulate Noreen Kelleher on being awarded the Cross of Merit of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem for her great work for the Order.

The Order is specially commissioned by the Holy Father to support the Christians and the Christian institutions in the Holy Land. Through member contributions the Order contributes approximately €350,000 annually to this cause being part of the €20 million contributed each year effectively underwriting the greater part of the expenses of the schools, orphanages, homes and community welfare of the small Christian community in the Holy Land.

Noreen has provided support services over the past 8 years. His Excellency Peter Durnin, Lieutenant in Ireland, being aware of her great work on behalf of the Order commended her work to the highest authority and His Eminence Cardinal Fernando Filoni the Grand Master appointed by the Pope to run the Order has personally awarded the Cross of Merit of the Order to Noreen. This is an honour bestowed only 4 times in the Irish Lieutenantcy's 40 years and is highly valued internationally.

Jesus, are you the one? It is hardly surprising that people missed your coming when even John the Baptist wasn't sure.
